Information for Applicants

Council seeks expressions of interest for community members to sit on the RADF Advisory Committee ("Committee").

The Committee consists of two Councillors and six independent community members who provide expert advice and recommendations to Council Officers on matters relating to the RADF program.

The RADF Advisory Committee assesses funding applications for recommendation to Council.

The assessment process is based on the principles and criteria for individual categories as set out in the RADF Guidelines.

Committee members will be asked to commit to serving for two (2) years and will need to reapply after a two (2) year term.

Responsibilities

The ongoing responsibilities of the committee are to:

- attend and participate in RADF meetings (approximately 3 per year)
- assess RADF applications via online platform SmartyGrants
- ensure that funding is aligned with the appropriate criteria and council priorities
- inform the RADF bidding and reporting cycles
- participate in RADF Committee training
- actively promote the RADF program through professional networks.
